The election is held through an electronic secret ballot by the current directors. Completed application packets must be received at the NBCC office no later than January 29, 2010.

In order to avoid potential conflicts of interest, we ask that NBCC Board members not hold leadership or policymaking positions in regional or national counseling associations, on national counseling certifying boards, or on state licensure boards.
